## VISION


Empowering individuals and communities to achieve sustainable livelihoods and economic independence, thereby fostering a brighter and more prosperous future for all.


## **ONE YEAR REVIEW**



In 2022, Pure Bayanihan achieved significant progress in its mission to empower communities across the Philippines. Through 10 diverse projects, we successfully reached 111 families across 14 communities. These initiatives focused on fostering sustainable livelihoods, enhancing food security, providing educational opportunities, and addressing other critical needs to uplift individuals and families. Our dedication to creating a brighter future for all is reflected in the positive impact we have made on the lives of those we serve.



## **2022 ACHIEVEMENTS**



Pure Bayanihan empowered 111 families across 14 communities in 2023 through 16 diverse projects:

- Microbusiness/Livelihood (4): Provided resources and training to establish sustainable income sources, ranging from retail stores to agricultural ventures.
- Education (1): Supported scholarships, school supplies, and educational initiatives for underprivileged students.
- Food (1): Addressed food insecurity through programs promoting access to nutritious meals and sustainable agriculture.
- **Agriculture (4**): Enhanced agricultural productivity and income by providing essential resources and training to farmers.



In 2022, Pure Bayanihan made significant progress in expanding our reach, strengthening programs, and fostering lasting change. Here are some of our key accomplishments:

#### 1. PROJECT 2022-011: FEEDING PROGRAM - NOURISHING BODIES, NURTURING MINDS

**Project Summary:** This 30-day feeding program addressed malnutrition among 22 vulnerable children in Quirino Province.

**Projec**t **Cost:** Pure Bayanihan provided \$4 USD per child per day for 3 meals, totaling \$2,640 USD for the 30-day program.

**Impact Achieved:** All 22 children achieved a normal nutritional status after the 30-day program. Additionally, the program facilitated the donation of a weighing scale to the school, employed a feeding cook, improved school attendance through breakfast provision, and promoted better hygiene habits among students. The successful model has garnered interest from the Department of Education for potential replication.





#### 2. PROJECT 2022-012: GOAT RAISING PROJECT -BUILDING SUSTAINABLE LIVELIHOODS

**Project Summary**: In Pangasinan, we empowered 10 farming families by providing them with breeding goats, enabling them to establish microbusinesses.

**Project Cost:** Php 100,000.00 (approximately \$1,754.39 USD) to purchase 20 goats (2 per family).

**Impact Achieved**: This project significantly increased income potential and improved food security for the beneficiary families. The goats provided an additional source of income through the sale of offspring and milk, while also contributing to better nutrition within the families. The project's success demonstrates the effectiveness of livestock-based livelihoods in empowering rural communities.







#### 3. PROJECT 2022-014: LIVELIHOOD SUPPORT FOR ROYO FAMILY - TRANSFORMING LIVES THROUGH ENTREPRENEURSHIP

**Project Summary:** This project provided the Royo family with seed funding to start a buy-and-sell business and a chicken coop. It also helped Ecko's brother reclaim his tricycle's franchise and license plate. **Project Cost:** Php 17,843.54 (\$318)

**Impact Achieved:** The project resulted in significantly increased income opportunities and restored livelihood for the family. By investing in both entrepreneurial pursuits and resolving legal obstacles, Pure Bayanihan empowered the Royo family to overcome financial challenges and create a path towards stability and self-sufficiency.







## 4. PROJECT 2022-015: FARM ANIMALS - CULTIVATING PROSPERITY THROUGH LIVESTOCK

**Project Summary:** By providing breeding livestock to families in Aurora and Bulacan, we enabled them to diversify their income sources and establish sustainable microbusinesses.

Project Cost: Php 280,043 (approximately \$5000)

**Impact Achieved:** This project successfully generated additional income for families and aided in the recovery of livelihoods impacted by swine flu. The provision of breeding livestock fostered economic resilience and contributed to long-term financial stability within the beneficiary communities.









#### 5. PROJECT 2022-016: WIPE EVERY TEAR LIVELIHOOD SUPPORT - EMPOWERING WOMEN, UPLIFTING FAMILIES

**Project Summary:** Through this project, we provided seed funding to families of women participating in Wipe Every Tear's program. These grants enabled the families to launch various livelihood projects.

Project Cost: Php 134,800 (approximately \$2407)

**Impact Achieved:** By alleviating financial burdens, this initiative empowered the women to focus on their education and personal goals while improving their families' overall well-being. The project not only reduced financial dependence but also instilled a sense of hope and opportunity for a brighter future.





#### 6. PROJECT 2022-017: DRIED FISHING BUSINESS (GUIBWAD) - REVIVING LIVELIHOODS AFTER THE PANDEMIC

**Project Summary:** The GuiBWAD association faced significant setbacks due to the pandemic. We provided additional capital to help them restart their dried fish business and launch a new venture in home essentials.

Project Cost: Php 120,660.00 (approximately \$2,154)

**Impact Achieved:** This project successfully revitalized the association's community enterprise and created diverse income streams. By providing crucial financial support, Pure Bayanihan enabled GuiBWAD to rebuild their business, explore new opportunities, and secure sustainable livelihoods for their members.







#### 7. PROJECT 2022-018: SEEDLINGS, FERTILIZERS, AND WATER PUMP - ENHANCING AGRICULTURAL PRODUCTIVITY

**Project Summary:** In Nueva Ecija, we supported 15 farming families by providing them with rice seedlings, fertilizers, and access to clean water through the installation of water pumps.

Project Cost: Php 161,500.00 (approximately \$2,848.21).

**Impact Achieved:** The project resulted in increased rice production, improved food security, and better access to clean water for the beneficiaries and the wider community. The provision of essential agricultural inputs and infrastructure led to a significant increase in crop yields, ensuring a more reliable source of sustenance and income for the families.







#### 8. PROJECT 2022-020: GOAT RAISING (PCGAMI) -UPLIFTING COMMUNITIES THROUGH LIVESTOCK

**Project Summary:** We continued our commitment to empowering indigent families by providing breeding goats to 10 households in Pangasinan.

Project Cost: Php 100,000.00 (approximately \$1785)

**Impact Achieved:** This initiative successfully generated income and improved living conditions for the beneficiary families. The goats served as a sustainable source of livelihood, providing the families with income from the sale of offspring and milk, ultimately improving their economic well-being.





#### 9. PROJECT 2022-021: NEGOSYO BIKE CARTS -ENHANCING MOBILITY FOR MICRO-ENTREPRENEURS

**Project Summary:** This project aimed to empower four economically disadvantaged families in Pangasinan by providing them with Negosyo Bike Carts. The initiative aims to enhance their existing vegetable vending businesses, increase income opportunities, and improve their overall well-being.

**Project Cost:** Php 100,000.00 (approximately \$1,754.39 USD) to purchase 4 bike carts.

**Impact Achieved:** These carts offered increased mobility and greater visibility, ultimately improving their earning potential and quality of life. The project directly addressed the challenges faced by these micro-entrepreneurs, providing them with the tools they needed to expand their businesses and achieve greater financial independence.








## **FINANCIAL STEWARDSHIP**

Pure Bayanihan is committed to responsible financial management. Your generous contributions allow us to maximize our impact. Here's a breakdown of our financial health:

In 2022, Pure Bayanihan's income totaled **\$98,022.19**, demonstrating a strong financial foundation for our mission-driven work. The majority of this income, **\$86,002.19 (87.74%)**, came from PIV donations, highlighting the significant internal support for our initiatives. Additionally, outside donors contributed **\$12,020.00 (12.26%)**, 100% of which was dedicated to impactful community projects, and showcasing growing external recognition and support for our work.

This diversified funding base allowed Pure Bayanihan to fund a variety of projects and programs, making a meaningful impact on the lives of individuals and communities across the Philippines.





#### **Transparency in Fund Allocation**

Pure Bayanihan is committed to transparency in all financial practices. To ensure the utmost clarity and accountability, we provide a detailed breakdown of our fund allocation:

**Community Projects (Mission-Driven Focus)**: In 2022, Pure Bayanihan dedicated \$21,969.78 to community projects, demonstrating our unwavering commitment to empowering communities across the Philippines. We are proud to uphold our promise that **100% of external donations** directly benefit the communities we serve, maximizing the impact of every contribution.

Administrative Expenses (Fully Covered by PIV Donations): Our administrative expenses, totaling \$57,914.82, were fully covered by PIV donations. This not only underscores the strong support of our internal stakeholders but also ensures that all external donations are exclusively used to fund impactful projects in the community.

This allocation ensures that every dollar donated by external supporters goes directly towards empowering communities across the Philippines. It also demonstrates the efficiency of our operations, as internal donations cover all administrative costs.
