VISION


Empowering individuals and communities to achieve sustainable livelihoods and economic independence, thereby fostering a brighter and more prosperous future for all.


ONE YEAR REVIEW



In 2023, Pure Bayanihan achieved a significant milestone in its mission to empower communities across the Philippines. Through a diverse portfolio of 14 projects, we successfully reached and positively impacted the lives of 141 families across 8 different communities. This remarkable achievement underscores our unwavering dedication to creating sustainable livelihoods, enhancing food security, and providing essential educational opportunities to uplift individuals and families.



2023 ACHIEVEMENTS



In 2023, Pure Bayanihan continued its commitment to community empowerment through a variety of projects:

- **Microbusiness/Livelihood**: 4 projects focused on empowering families with sustainable income sources.
- **Education**: 3 projects supported scholarships, supplies, and educational initiatives.
- **Food**: 1 project addressed food insecurity through feeding programs and sustainable agriculture.
- Housing: 2 projects provided safe and secure housing for families in need.
- **Agriculture**: 2 project supported farmers by providing agricultural supplies.
- Others: 2 project focused on community development.

Through this diverse approach, Pure Bayanihan continues to make a significant difference in the lives of individuals and families across the Philippines, fostering economic empowerment, education, and sustainable development.



In 2023, Pure Bayanihan made significant progress in expanding our reach, strengthening programs, and fostering lasting change. Here are some of our key accomplishments:

1. PROJECT 2023-022: HOUSING AND LIVELIHOOD PROJECT

Project Summary: In partnership with PABAHAYanihan, we launched this project to address both housing and livelihood needs for five indigent families in Davao Oriental.

Project Cost: Php 210,000/ (\$4024.25)

Impact Achieved: This project created a profound impact on the lives of six families in Davao Oriental. By constructing safe and secure homes on higher ground, we not only provided shelter but also a sense of security and stability. The added benefit of livelihood funding for small businesses empowered these families to generate income, fostering self-reliance and long-term economic stability.





2. PROJECT 2023-023: FOOD SINAG CART

Project Summary: The Sinag ng Hilaga youth organization at the University of Eastern Philippines (UEP) launched the Livelihood Program to support financially disadvantaged students with mobile food carts.

Project Cost: Php 117,050/ (\$2220.77)

Impact Achieved: The program's impact has been significant, with students experiencing newfound financial independence, reducing dropout rates due to financial constraints, and fostering a culture of self-reliance within the university community.







3. PROJECT 2023-024: DORM ESSENTIALS, KOLONG, AND BIGASAN LIVELIHOOD

Project Summary: This project supported Pastor Fred's initiative to provide housing and education for students from Kalapnit who lacked local educational options.

Project Cost: P418,896/ (\$7849.57)

Impact Achieved: This project has had a profound impact on the educational opportunities of Kalapnit students. The construction of a new dorm, improved technology access through computers and internet connectivity, the establishment of a community rice bank (Bigasan) for income generation, and the provision of transportation have created a more conducive and supportive learning environment. These interventions have empowered students to pursue their education with greater ease and confidence.







4. PROJECT 2023-025: SEED CAPITAL

Project Summary: Pure Bayanihan renewed its partnership with the Brgy. Binuklutan ICC, providing food assistance and supporting their transition to individual organic farms.

Project Cost: ₱212,568.87/ (\$3987.62) for 25 families.

Impact Achieved: The project has been instrumental in supporting the resilience and self-sufficiency of the Brgy. Binuklutan ICC. By providing food assistance during their transition and investing in sustainable farming through the provision of non-GMO seeds, the project has strengthened the community's ability to provide for themselves while promoting environmentally friendly agricultural practices.







5. PROJECT 2023-026: FISHING BUSINESS

Project Summary: This project empowered 10 indigenous families in Sitio Guh-ban, Pangasinan, by providing a fishing boat, solar-powered lights, and a water hose.

Project Cost: ₱292,650/ (\$5454.69)

Impact Achieved: The provision of essential resources, including a fishing boat for livelihood, solar-powered lights for safer homes, and a water hose for agricultural use, has significantly improved the quality of life for these indigenous families. Increased income, access to clean energy, and enhanced agricultural productivity are among the notable outcomes of this project.







7. PROJECT 2023-027: KOLONG KOLONG AND ALTERNATIVE LIVELIHOOD

Project Summary: This project empowered 10 kangkong farming families in Barotac Nuevo, Iloilo, by providing transportation and financial assistance for alternative livelihoods during the dry season.

Project Cost: ₱250,000.00/ (\$4660.44)

Impact Achieved: This two-pronged approach has successfully empowered kangkong farmers. By providing transportation, farmers gained direct access to markets, resulting in increased income and improved living standards. The additional support for alternative livelihoods during the dry season has ensured a consistent income stream, fostering financial resilience and long-term stability.







8. PROJECT 2023-028: SOLAR PANELS

Project Summary: Twelve families in Sitio Pulo, Marilao, Bulacan, received solar panels to address their lack of electricity.

Project Cost: Php 198,000/ (\$3694.44)

Impact Achieved: The installation of solar panels has transformed the lives of these families by providing them with clean and reliable energy. The benefits extend beyond convenience, enhancing safety by eliminating the fire risk associated with candles and creating opportunities for education and economic advancement through extended working hours.







9. PROJECT 2023-029: ADOPT A TREE PROGRAM FOR GREEN EARTH FOUNDATION

- **Project Summary:** A \$5,000 donation supported Green Earth Foundation's tree-planting initiatives.
- **Impact Achieved:** The donation played a crucial role in nurturing over 120,000 seedlings, empowering rural communities, and contributing to the fight against climate change. Each seedling represents a potential for a healthier planet and a more sustainable future.











10. PROJECT 2023-030: BBF PAN MASS CHALLENGE TEAM 2023 DONATION

Project Summary: A \$500 donation was made to the Dana-Farber Cancer Institute to support cancer research and treatment.

Impact Achieved: This generous contribution supported groundbreaking research and treatment efforts at the Dana-Farber Cancer Institute, advancing the fight against cancer and offering hope to patients and their families.





11. PROJECT 2023-031: PABAON PROJECT

Project Summary: The Amazing Faith in Jesus Christian Church Scholarship Program provided weekly allowances for food and transportation to 46 underprivileged students in Navotas.

Project Cost: Php 224,400.00/ (\$4142.73)

Impact Achieved: The program's impact is evident in the success of its beneficiaries. Six students are graduating high school this year, and five past graduates are now employed, demonstrating the program's effectiveness in breaking the cycle of poverty through education.







12. PROJECT 2023-032: SCHOOL SUPPLIES & UNIFORMS

Project Summary: In partnership with Amazing Faith in Jesus Christ, this project provided school supplies and uniforms to 13 students in Navotas.

Project Cost: Php 16,263/ (\$290)

Impact Achieved: By alleviating the financial burden of educational expenses, the project empowered students to focus on their studies and provided them with the tools they needed to succeed.









13. PROJECT 2023-032: PROVIDING A BRIGHTER FUTURE FOR HANNA MAE'S FAMILY

Project Summary: : The Safe Haven Project repaired a damaged home and provided rice assistance to Hanna Mae's family.

Project Cost: ₱44,106.00/(\$795.89) and ₱13,200.00 for rice assistance.

Impact Achieved: The project improved the family's health and well-being by creating a safe and comfortable living environment. Addressing basic needs allowed Hanna Mae and Rose Mae to concentrate on their studies, leading to better educational outcomes and a brighter future for the entire family.







14. PROJECT 2023-033: BUILDING A BRIGHTER FUTURE, ONE BOOK AT A TIME

Project Summary: In partnership with Pivfit, we purchased a bookshelf for Pastor Henry's group to provide easy access to a collection of donated books, enriching their learning opportunities. Additionally, we organized a joyful Christmas party for the children, spreading holiday cheer and creating memorable experiences.

Project Cost: ₱5,000/ (\$92.89)

Impact Achieved: By providing easy access to a variety of books, this project fostered a love of reading, enhanced learning opportunities, and empowered students with knowledge and inspiration. The bookshelf also serves as a valuable resource for the wider community.







14. PROJECT 2023-034: DEMAND SCIENCE TEAM PHILIPPINES INC X PURE BAYANIHAN

Project Summary: In collaboration with Pure Bayanihan, the Demand Science Team Philippines Inc. (DSTD) successfully executed a series of community outreach initiatives across the Philippines, reaching over 300 underprivileged children. The project focused on providing essential resources, educational support, and joyful experiences to uplift and empower these children.

Impact Achieved: This collaborative effort exemplified the spirit of Bayanihan, bringing together DSTD and Pure Bayanihan to provide tangible support and create lasting positive change in the lives of underprivileged children. The project not only addressed immediate needs but also instilled hope for a brighter future, demonstrating the power of community collaboration in fostering a more equitable and compassionate society.










FINANCIAL STEWARDSHIP

Pure Bayanihan is committed to responsible financial management. Your generous contributions allow us to maximize our impact. Here's a breakdown of our financial health:

Pure Bayanihan's 2023 financial data reflects a healthy and diversified income stream, totaling **\$138,535.27**.

Strong Internal Support: PIV donations constituted a significant portion of the income, accounting for \$79,285.27 (57.23%). This demonstrates a strong commitment from the organization's internal stakeholders and a solid financial foundation.

Significant External Support: Outside donors contributed a substantial \$59,250.00 (42.77%). Notably, **100% of external donations** were channeled directly into impactful community projects, underscoring Pure Bayanihan's dedication to its mission. This diversified funding model not only showcases growing recognition and support for the organization's work but also ensures its long-term sustainability.





Transparency in Fund Allocation

Pure Bayanihan is committed to transparency in all financial practices. To ensure the utmost clarity and accountability, we provide a detailed breakdown of our fund allocation:

Community Projects (Mission-Driven Focused): In 2023, Pure Bayanihan dedicated \$46,044.27 in community projects, demonstrating our unwavering commitment to empowering communities across the Philippines. We are proud to fulfill our promise that **100% of external donations** go directly to these initiatives, maximizing the positive impact on the lives we touch.

Administrative Expenses (Fully covered by PIV donations): Pure Bayanihan's operational expenses totaled \$64,090.47 entirely funded by PIV donations. This demonstrates the strong commitment of our internal stakeholders and our effective financial management. By covering administrative costs internally, we guarantee that every dollar from external donations goes directly towards creating positive change within the community.
