Project Title: Goat Raising



Project Summary:



The project successfully distributed goats to the 10 beneficiary families, providing them with a foundation for their goat-rearing enterprises.




Increased Income

The project has contributed to enhanced food security for the beneficiaries, as they now have access to a source of nutritious goat milk and meat for their own consumption..




Community Empowerment
